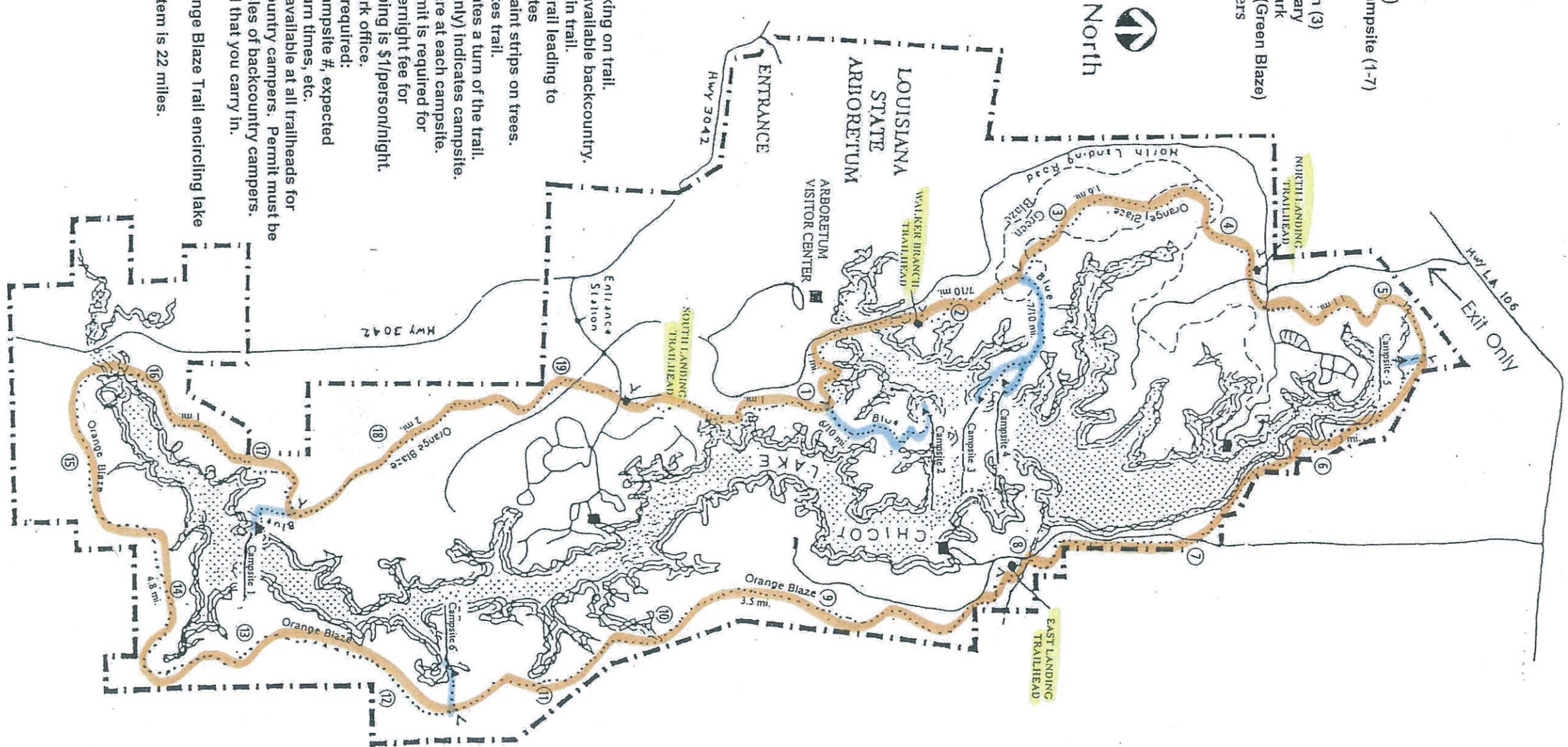


**LEGEND**

**Trail System**

- \*Take water for drinking on trail. No potable water available backcountry.
- \*Orange Blaze is main trail.
- \*Blue Blaze is spur trail leading to 6 primitive campsites
- \*Blazes are 2"X 6" paint strips on trees.
- \*Single blaze indicates trail.
- \*Double blaze indicates a turn of the trail.
- \*Triple blaze (Blue only) indicates campsite.
- \*Fire ring with grill are at each campsite.
- \*A Backcountry permit is required for overnight use. Overnight fee for backcountry camping is \$1/person/night.
- \*Obtain permit at park office.
- A trip plan will be required: expected route, campsite #, expected departure and return times, etc.
- \*Vehicle Parking is available at all trailheads for hikers and backcountry campers. Permit must be displayed in vehicles of backcountry campers.
- \*Please carry out all that you carry in.
- \*Total length of Orange Blaze Trail encircling lake is 19 miles.
- \*The entire trail system is 22 miles.
